

Daniel Salomon is a prominent awards-winning singer-songwriter, musical producer, and composer for film, television, and theater, with numerous awards to his name.

since 1998 he has played, arranged, and produced music for numerous leading Israeli artists such as Aviv Geffen, Shlomo Artzi, Ivri Lider and many others. He was also a member of Steven Wilson's (Porcupine Tree) band - Blackfield, as a pianist, singer, arranger, and producer.

In 2003, Daniel released his first solo album, "Daniel Salomon," which received critical acclaim and won the Acum Golden Feather (the Israeli BMI). He released his second solo album, "Many Ways," in 2005, which also won the gold record and is still considered one of the most highly regarded albums in Israeli music history. Since then, Daniel has released seven studio albums and a live concert album, all of which have been highly appreciated and successful in the Israeli music industry. A few of Daniel's hit singles are considered to be the most-played songs on Israeli radio in the last 25 years.

In addition to his successful music career, Daniel has also composed soundtracks and songs for films and documentaries, including "Perfect Strangers", "The Secrets", and "Someone to Jog With". He has also composed music and songs for a lot of TV series like "The Beauty Queen of Jerusalem" (Netflix), and stage productions such as the classic plays "All My Sons" (Arthur Miller) and "Simple Story" (Shai Agnon), for prestigious institutions like the Israeli National Theatre and The British Theatre. Notably, Daniel has been honored twice with the Israeli Theatre Award for his exceptional work.

Graduated from Art High School in Haifa Daniel and studied classical music at Donia Weizman and Robin Conservatories as a pianist. Began writing his own music and lyrics at the age of 12 then pursued his passion for composition at the Rimmon School of Jazz and Contemporary Music (the Barkley branch of Israel). He also studied arrangement and conducting with Professor Yitzhak Sedai, who was one of the greatest classical music teachers in the world.

Daniel Salomon is one of the most appreciated musicians in Israel and works at his studio based in Tel Aviv/Berlin on many albums and music as a producer, singer-songwriter, and composer.
